The die hard woody owner may think it preposterous, but I have to disagree. Our Callinectes 16 is so easy to own. Her fiberglass hull is virtually maintenance free. No need to worry about swelling planks or plank movement while underway in less than perfect water.

Her engine and drive set move her so gracefully across the water at 32 MPH burning only two

gallons of fuel per hour. And if you are in a hurry, or want to shame the Clorox bottles into submission, you can goose her to 50 MPH without worrying about dental work and a bottom job.

She turns on a dime, can float in 7 inches of water, can be beached, goes on plane before you can lose your hat, and keeps you dry where an old woody would have you looking for your foulies.

Not to mention her flawlessly smooth hull, durable bright mahogany deck, chromed hardware, and standard ISO / ABYC construction.



And, every hull is outfitted to customer specifications for a flat fee. That means each boat is a one of kind using our proven hull and power plant. All that in a 1200 pound package of classic styling.
