The Callinectes Yacht Tender marries fine woodworking to power and safety on the water. Weighing less than 1500 pounds, the Tender performs like a sports car on the water and is easily lifted for storing. The classic runabout is built around a novel and modern power plant: a turbo-charged engine coupled to a jet pump. At speeds of 50 mph, this tender delivers sleek styling with a safe and comfortable ride.

This remarkable Tender is built to American Boat and Yacht Council (ABYC) and International Standards Organization (ISO) specifications. Among the standard features are: three deck lift points, bow and stern tie downs, level flotation, interior courtesy lighting, and a swim platform. Seating for five is augmented with ample and intelligently designed storage. The Tender handles well in protected waterways, with a draft of 7" at rest. Ship to shore with fuel-efficiency, low emissions, and elegant comfort: the Callinectes Yacht Tender delivers.

Callinectes (Latin for "beautiful swimmer") Boatworks, is a family operated semi-custom builder specializing in the design and construction of classically styled runabouts and yacht tenders. Hulls are constructed using the vacuum infusion process of cored fiberglass bonded to an internal grid system creating a strong, rigid and light monocoque structure. These modern hulls are then coupled to hand-crafted mahogany decks and a fuel-efficient, low-emissions engine driving a jet-pump.
